Requesting a Consult for Vasectomy Reversal

A consultation is required before scheduling a vasectomy reversal surgery. This allows a thorough discussion of all aspects of reversal surgery, including your medical history, details of the surgery, success rates, potential complications, alternatives to reversal, and recommendations for a safe and uneventful recovery.

Consultations with Dr. Finnerty take place either by phone or in a private Zoom meeting, and generally take between 30 to 45 minutes.

To request a consultation for vasectomy reversal, here are the steps to take:

- Send an email to consults@micro-reversals.com requesting a consult. Include your full name, date of birth, spouse/partner's name, and the number of years since your vasectomy.
- Once this email has been received, you will receive a return email which will include links to several secure online forms. These include:
 - Patient information form (name, address, etc.)
 - Financial policies
 - Medical history form
 - Privacy policies & attestation
 - Telemedicine consent

These will need to be completed (online), and signed with a secure signature. They are maintained on a highly secure, HIPAA-compliant server for your privacy and protection.

- If you have had an unsuccessful reversal surgery in the past by another surgeon, we request the operative report from that surgery. This can be obtained from the surgeon, or the facility where the procedure was performed. Semen analysis reports (sperm counts) after your previous surgery are also very desirable. A secure link will be provided to upload this information to us.
- Once the forms and information have been completed, a mutually agreeable time will be arranged for the consult.
- Please state if you would prefer a consult by phone or a video consult with Zoom. If you prefer a phone consultation, please forward your preferred contact phone number. If you prefer a Zoom meeting, you will be sent a link for the meeting, which you join by clicking the link at the time of the consult. This requires that you have Zoom installed on your computer, phone, or tablet; it may be downloaded from their web site at https://zoom.us/support/download. You do not have to have an account with Zoom to use it.
- There is no charge for the consultation, and no obligation to schedule surgery.
